We're looking a licensed clinician to join our compassionate, family-focused team. We offer an extremely flexible and friendly work environment, medical, dental, retirement, disability, and supplemental benefits, and a chance to a better future for generations to come.

Our **Family Services Therapists** serve as members of a multidisciplinary team that provides professional counseling to a diverse client population under the joint direction of our Clinical Director and Director of Clinical Programs. As members of the treatment team, Family Services Therapists III (licensed in the state of Tennessee) are responsible for providing a broad range of services that include individual, group, and family therapy; crisis intervention; and managing all associated assessments and reports. Therapists work closely with guardians, families, and referral sources to provide coordinated care.

Primary Responsibilities:
